### Calpol

It is that time of year when everyone starts to get poorly & feel a little under the weather. Please note the following from our policy:

*If a parent knows their child will need a dose of Calpol (or equivalent) whilst attending nursery, that day, we require the parents to provide their own medicine, which should be clearly labelled with the child's name, and pre-sign the medication consent form.*

*We will not administer Calpol and Ibuprofen together or as alternate doses at nursery. If a child needs both types of medication to be administered in the same day, we would not consider them well enough to be attending nursery.*

We do administer nursery Calpol using your registration form but this is for children who become unwell at nursery.
